## Individualized Learning Plan

In order to prepare students for academic success, counselors at Crossland High School work with them one-on-one to create and update an *Individualized Learning Plan* every year. This plan lists the mandated courses and academic standards for each year and provides a template students and counselors can use in creating an appropriate four-year course trajectory. Before beginning course planning, counselors schedule individual meetings with students to discuss and record strengths and talents, colleges of interest, academic goals and appropriate steps toward meeting them, and career goals. Students also list activities they plan to participate in during the school year.

Grade 9 –

Students below grade level in Reading will be scheduled into Read 180 – full year  
Students below grade level in Math will be scheduled into Algebra Daily block – full year  
Advanced students will be scheduled into Honors Classes, 1 day Algebra and Foreign Language  
All students scheduled for Foundations of Technology and Personal Fitness courses.

Grade 10 –

Advanced students go into AP Gov instead of LSN  
Schedule Foreign Language completer as possible (3 years)  
Pre IB students should be in all Honors classes (Ms. Epps will furnish a list of students)  
America' Choice and Read 180 are options only if cannot be filled with 9<sup>th</sup> graders

Grade 11 –

All students scheduled into SAT classes  
Schedule into Technical Academy at student request  
Schedule all grade level or above readers into AP Language  
Schedule Honors students into AP Psych or AP Human  
Schedule Foreign Language as possible (3 years)  
Special Ed students not meeting foreign language requirements can go into Technical Academy  
IB students to be identified by April 30 for IB schedule – earmark candidates (Ms. Epps will furnish a list)

Grade 12 –

All students scheduled into College Summit classes  
Schedule 4<sup>th</sup> year of Math and Science as possible  
Schedule all honors students into multiple AP courses  
Schedule all grade level students into an AP elective  
Special Ed students not meeting Foreign Language requirements can go into Career Issues and Work study or Technical Academy  
Identify students to go into AVP classes (schedule TBA)
